INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE AND STRATEGY

The Fund aims primarily for capital growth over the medium to long term by investing substantially in a selection of exchange-listed equities. Investments in bank deposits and other short-term fixed income instruments may be kept for liquidity and portfolio re-balancing purposes. The Fund's benchmark is the Philippine Stock Exchange Composite Index (PSEi).

CLIENT SUITABILITY

A client profiling process should be performed prior to participating in the Fund to guide the prospective investor if the Fund is suited to his/her investment objectives and risk tolerance. Clients are advised to read the Declaration of Trust/Plan Rules of the Fund, which may be obtained from the Trustee, before deciding to invest.

- ♦The BDO Institutional Equity Fund is primarily suitable for entities with balanced risk tolerance and with trust and fiduciary accounts and investment management accounts with the Trustee or its subsidiaries who are tax-exempt and whose tax-exemptions are supported by Bureau of Internal Revenue (BIR) tax-exemption certificates who seek potentially higher return through stock market investments but are also aware of the possibility of capital losses that such investments may entail.
- ♦Participants/trustors are recommended to stay invested in the Fund for more than three (3) years. The Fund is not suitable for short-term investing.

KEY RISKS AND RISK MANAGEMENT

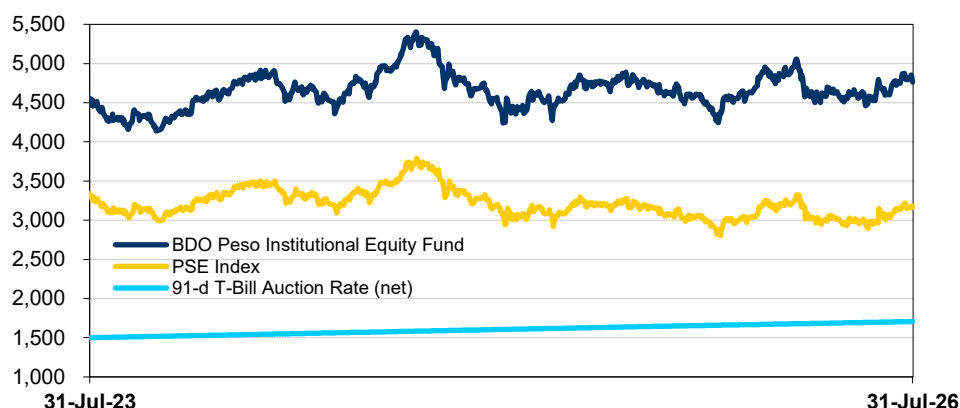

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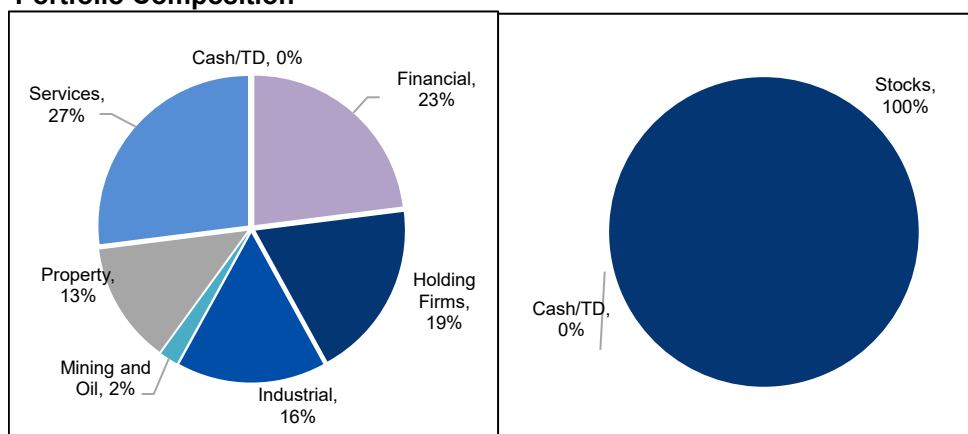

OUTLOOK AND STRATEGY

The Philippine Stock Exchange Index (PSEi) rebounded in July, gaining 3.3% month-on-month to close at 6,236.44. The market maintained its footing above the 6,000 level as easing inflation provided support to investor sentiment, while bargain hunting emerged in select large-cap stocks that had previously underperformed. Foreign investors also returned as net buyers, reflecting a rotation away from AI- driven technology trades toward undervalued and lagging markets such as the Philippines. Approximately US\$67 million in net inflows was recorded during the month.

Another notable development during the month was the PSEi's August rebalancing, which was implemented at the end of July. Maynilad Water Services (MYNLD) replaced Converge ICT Solutions (CNVRG) in the benchmark index. In addition, the Philippine Stock Exchange announced revisions to its index methodology, including reduced free-float requirements and updated liquidity screening measures aimed at enhancing sector representation and overall investability.

INVESTMENT POLICY / PROSPECTIVE INVESTMENTS

The Fund may invest in exchange-listed equities and fixed income securities, deposits in the Trustee's bank or in other banks, securities issued or guaranteed by the Philippine Government or the BSP and tradable securities issued by any supranational entity. Subject to BSP guidelines and the Trustee's Trust Committee approval, the Fund may also avail of financial derivative instruments solely for the purpose of hedging risk exposures, as well as invest in other tradable investment outlets/categories as may be deemed suitable for the Fund.

The Fund's Declaration of Trust (DOT) provides that its Single Exposure Limit Policy is deemed amended should the BSP amend the exposure limit requirements of UITFs. Effective June 11, 2026, pursuant to BSP Circular 1234, the Fund's Single Exposure Limit Policy shall be as follows: "The combined exposure of the Fund to any entity shall not exceed 15% of the market value of the Fund: Provided, that the investment in exchange-traded equity securities shall be subject to a 20% exposure limit to a single entity/issuer; Provided, further, that any exposure exceeding 15% up to the applicable 20% limit, shall be solely in the form of investments in exchange-traded equity securities of the same entity/issuer."

The Fund aims to provide returns equal or better than the returns of listed stocks represented by the Philippine Stock Exchange index (PSEi), the Fund's benchmark. The stated benchmark is a measure that is used to compare the performance of the Fund. The benchmark also represents the Fund's portfolio as well as the movements in stock market prices affecting the Fund's investments. The PSEi is made up of the top 30 largest and most active listed companies, chosen to represent the general movement of the stock market. Subject: Amendment of Exposure Limits of Unit Investment Trust Funds (UITFs)

Please be advised that the Bangko Sentral ng Pilipinas (BSP) has issued Circular 1234 which amends the maximum exposure limits of unit investment trust funds (UITFs) relative to exchange-traded equity securities. In relation to this, the Declaration of Trust (DOT) of the following actively-managed multi-asset and equity UITFs provides that their Single Exposure Limit Policy is deemed amended should the BSP amend the exposure limit requirements of UITFs:

- **BDO Peso Multi-Asset Fund**
- **BDO Equity Fund**
- **BDO ESG Equity Fund**
- **BDO Dividend Fund**
- **BDO Focused Equity Fund**
- **BDO Institutional Equity Fund**

Effective June 11, 2026, pursuant to BSP Circular 1234, the Single Exposure Limit Policy of the abovementioned UITFs shall be as follows:

"The combined exposure of the Fund to any entity shall not exceed 15% of the market value of the Fund: Provided, that the investment in exchange-traded equity securities shall be subject to a 20% exposure limit to a single entity/issuer; Provided, further, that any exposure exceeding 15% up to the applicable 20% limit, shall be solely in the form of investments in exchange-traded equity securities of the same entity/issuer."

The updated Single Exposure Limit Policy of the above BDO UITFs aims to be consistent with current BSP regulations and will provide the fund managers with additional flexibility in managing these Funds.
