INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE AND STRATEGY

The Fund aims primarily for capital growth over the medium to long-term by investing in a selection of exchange-listed equities. The Fund's benchmark is the Philippine Stock Exchange Composite Index (PSEi).

CLIENT SUITABILITY

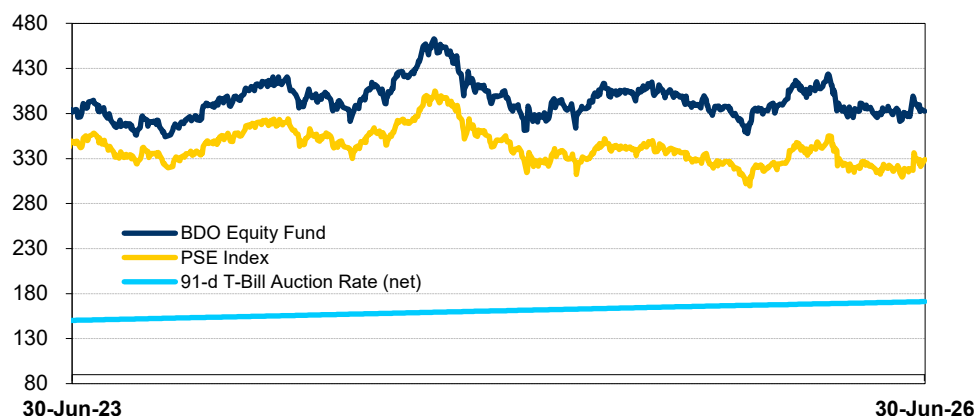

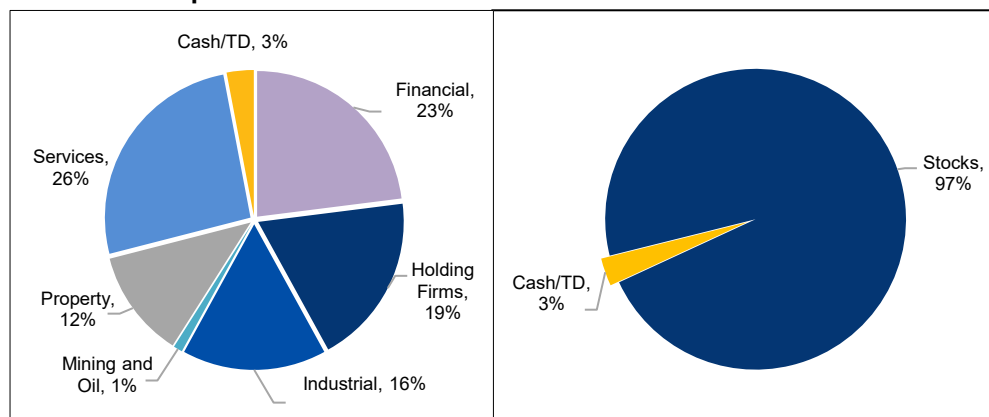

OTHER DISCLOSURES**OUTLOOK AND STRATEGY**

Local share prices jumped in June as easing geopolitical tension in the Middle East improved market sentiment. The stock market recovered above 6,000 level after US President Trump announced a ceasefire agreement between US and Iran. The peace talks also drove global oil prices sharply lower by as much 5% on expectation of a fully opened Strait of Hormuz. Market gained momentum throughout the month and closed at 6,037.17, up 4.7% m/m. Leading the rally was ICT (+18.3% m/m) driven by strong foreign buying. Further strength came from BSP's decision to increase the single-stock exposure limit for UITFs to 20% from 15%. GLO (+12.3% m/m) also posted notable gains following the filing of the GCASH/Mynt IPO. The offer size could raise as much as Php92.3 billion (\$1.5 billion) and potentially become the largest IPO in Philippine history. Despite the solid recovery in June, the PSEi still ended the first half of the year slightly negative, down 16 points YTD. Meanwhile, headline inflation continued to trend lower, slowing to 6.4% in June from 6.8% in May, driven by lower transport and fuel costs as well as stabilizing food prices. Overall, investor confidence was quite upbeat on easing geopolitical risk and inflation concerns.

INVESTMENT POLICY / PROSPECTIVE INVESTMENTS

The Fund may invest in exchange-listed equities and fixed income securities, deposits in the Trustee's bank or in other banks, securities issued or guaranteed by the Philippine Government or the BSP and tradable securities issued by any supranational entity. Subject to BSP guidelines and the Trustee's Trust Committee approval, the Fund may also avail of financial derivative instruments solely for the purpose of hedging risk exposures, as well as invest in other tradable investment outlets/categories as may be deemed suitable for the Fund.

The stated benchmark is a measure that is used to compare the performance of the Fund. The benchmark also represents the Fund's portfolio as well as the movements in stock market prices affecting the Fund's investments. The PSEi is made up of the top 30 largest and most active listed companies, chosen to represent the general movement of the stock market. Subject: Amendment of Exposure Limits of Unit Investment Trust Funds (UITFs)

Please be advised that the Bangko Sentral ng Pilipinas (BSP) has issued Circular 1234 which amends the maximum exposure limits of unit investment trust funds (UITFs) relative to exchange-traded equity securities. In relation to this, the Declaration of Trust (DOT) of the following actively-managed multi-asset and equity UITFs provides that their Single Exposure Limit Policy is deemed amended should the BSP amend the exposure limit requirements of UITFs:

- **BDO Peso Multi-Asset Fund**
- **BDO Equity Fund**
- **BDO ESG Equity Fund**
- **BDO Dividend Fund**
- **BDO Focused Equity Fund**
- **BDO Institutional Equity Fund**

Effective June 11, 2026, pursuant to BSP Circular 1234, the Single Exposure Limit Policy of the abovementioned UITFs shall be as follows:

"The combined exposure of the Fund to any entity shall not exceed 15% of the market value of the Fund: Provided, that the investment in exchange-traded equity securities shall be subject to a 20% exposure limit to a single entity/issuer; Provided, further, that any exposure exceeding 15% up to the applicable 20% limit, shall be solely in the form of investments in exchange-traded equity securities of the same entity/issuer."

The updated Single Exposure Limit Policy of the above BDO UITFs aims to be consistent with current BSP regulations and will provide the fund managers with additional flexibility in managing these Funds.
