**INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE AND STRATEGY**

The Fund aims to achieve capital appreciation by investing in a diversified portfolio of peso denominated short to long-term fixed income securities, equity securities, and other allowable investments for UITFs. The allocation for equity securities shall not exceed 80% of the total portfolio of the Fund. The Fund's benchmark is 50% Philippine Stock Exchange Composite Index (PSEi) and 50% Markit iBoxx ALBI Philippines 1-5 (Domestic) Index (IBXXPH15).

**CLIENT SUITABILITY**

A client profiling process should be performed prior to participating in the Fund to guide the prospective investor if the Fund is suited to his/her investment objectives and risk tolerance. Clients are advised to read the Declaration of Trust/Plan Rules of the Fund, which may be obtained from the Trustee, before deciding to invest.

- ♦The BDO Peso Multi-Asset Fund is primarily suitable for individual and corporate investors with balanced risk appetite and who are aware of the opportunity for high yields that portfolios with stock market investments may provide but are also knowledgeable of the possibility of capital losses that such investments may entail.
- ♦Participants/trustors are recommended to stay invested in the Fund for more than three (3) years.

**KEY RISKS AND RISK MANAGEMENT**

You should not invest in this Fund if you do not understand or are not comfortable with the accompanying risks.

**Interest Rate Risk.** This is the possibility for an investor to experience losses due to changes in interest rates. The purchase and sale of a debt instrument may result in profit or loss because the value of a debt instrument changes inversely with prevailing interest rates.

As interest rates rise, bond prices fall. The higher the duration, the more the NAVPU will fluctuate in relation to changes in interest rates. All the Fund's investment outlets undergo evaluation in accordance with the Trustee's Investment Policy Manual. Regulatory exposure limits are monitored on a regular basis. The Fund may also use financial derivative instruments solely for the purpose of hedging risk exposures.

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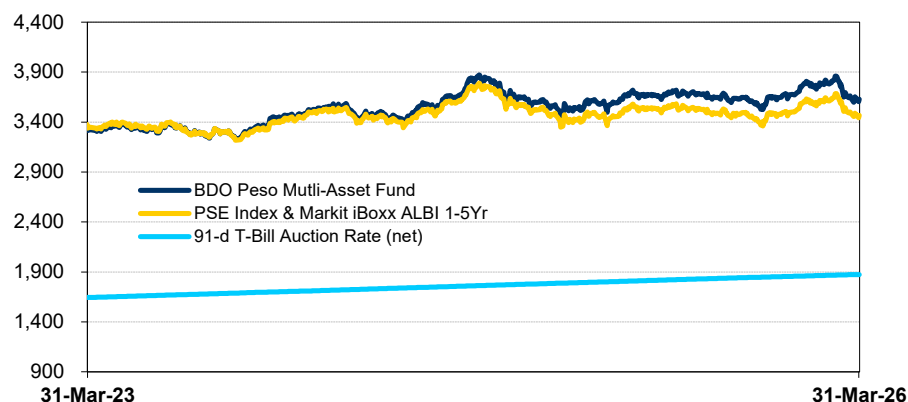

**Fund's NAVPU vs Benchmark & Risk-Free Rate**

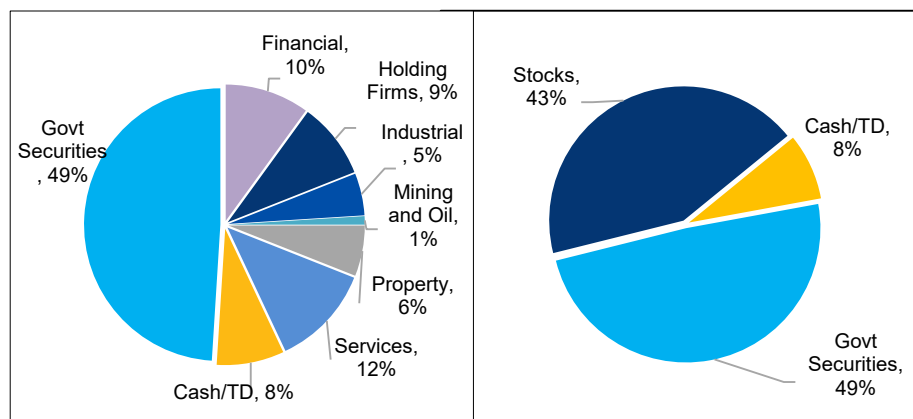

**OUTLOOK AND STRATEGY**

It was a melancholy March for the local equities market as the PSEi plunged by 10.02% m/m or 662 points, to close the first quarter at 5,9480.94. The Index slid to a four-month low amid heightened geopolitical tensions stemming from the Middle East conflict. Worries over the closure of the Strait of Hormuz and oil prices trading above \$100 per barrel, triggered heavy selling across the market. Inflation fears further weighed on sentiment, as elevated oil prices raised the prospect of the BSP raising interest rates. Headline inflation accelerated to 4.1% in March, breaching BSP's target range of 2% to 4%. Negative sentiment was also driven by the peso weakening beyond the 60:\$ level. As such, foreign investors were net sellers amounting to \$231M in net foreign outflows. Strong gains built up from January to February rally were wiped out by March with the Index slipping below 5,900 level. Towards end of March, the market saw a slight uptick supported by quarter-end window dressing activity. Overall, the PSEi ended the first quarter of the year down 1.72%.

The Philippine CPI for February printed at 2.4%, at par with the market consensus and higher than previous month's report at 2.0%. In an off-cycle policy meeting resulting from the Middle East conflict, the BSP kept the policy rate unchanged at 4.25%, emphasizing the unnecessary pain rate hikes would entail. As the fund continues to take advantage of elevated interest rates, majority of the fund's investments are in government securities with a strong preference for liquid benchmark issuances.

**INVESTMENT POLICY / PROSPECTIVE INVESTMENTS**

The Fund may invest in exchange-listed equities and fixed income securities, deposits in the trustee's bank or in other banks, securities issued or guaranteed by the Philippine Government or the BSP and tradable securities issued by any supranational entity. Subject to BSP guidelines and the Trustee's Trust Committee approval, the Fund may also avail of financial derivative instruments solely for the purpose of hedging risk exposures, as well as invest in other tradable investment outlets/categories as may be deemed suitable for the Fund.

The stated benchmark is a measure that is used to compare the performance of the Fund. The benchmark also represents the Fund's portfolio as well as the movements in interest rates and stock market prices affecting the Fund's investments.

The Philippine Stock Exchange index (PSEi) measures the performance of the Philippine Stock Market. The PSEi is made up of the top 30 largest and most active listed companies, chosen to represent the general movement of the stock market.
