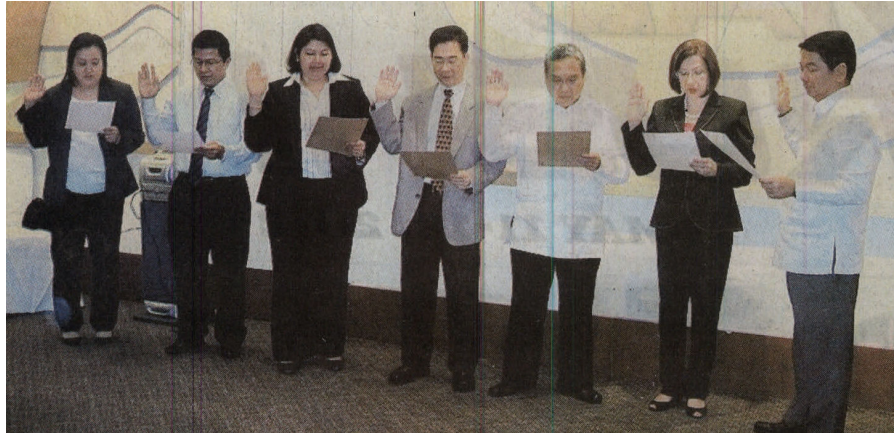


Reniedo takes oath as ABROI treasurer
